Treatment Summary

Patient: 13 year-old male

Chief Concern: The patient wanted a beautiful smile using a non-extraction protocol. Failure to fully erupt the canines would not be an acceptable outcome. Getting full cooperation and compliance from such a young patient was “job one.” We motivated him by saying that he would graduate from Invisalign® treatment to a new “million dollar smile.”

Diagnosis: Right: Class III
Left: Class III

The patient had severely crowded permanent dentition and an anterior crossbite with lingually inclined posterior teeth. All four canines had failed to fully erupt due to the crowding.

Length of Treatment: 40 months

of Aligners Used: Upper: 30 + 22 + 22 + 15
Lower: 30 + 22 + 22 + 15

Additional Treatment: Propel® microosseous perforations were used to increase the rate of orthodontic tooth movement.

Retention: Upper: Vivera® retainers
Lower: Vivera® retainers
